Phil Haydon, Ph.D. and the Sail For Epilepsy team are on a mission to sail the oceans of the world to raise awareness of epilepsy. Sail For Epilepsy will disembark from Boston, USA in 2021 to: inspire people with epilepsy; raise awareness for those with epilepsy; raise funds to support research into the causes of intractable epilepsy, and to educate the population about epilepsy. This three-year voyage is about more than sailing around the world. Sail For Epilepsy will make landfall during the project to engage with local epilepsy communities. Sail For Epilepsy will post photos, videos, and blogs as they travel the globe. A ship tracker will be available on the Sail For Epilepsy website and there are plans to have real-time interactions with people living with epilepsy while underway.

At the onset of the Sail For Epilepsy program, a proportion of all funds donated will flow through to their partners, Epilepsy Foundation New England and Tufts University School of Medicine. The balance will be used to support the Sail For Epilepsy program. At the end of the five-year program, all assets will be sold and all funds will be donated to these nonprofit partners.
